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8 Weeks 2 Wellness: A Program that Serves



e are armed with one of the most powerful messages, the Health Message, that teaches and instructs us how to live healthy wholistically — mind, body, and soul. Being well should be desired by all of us. Being in a state of wellness makes life so much more productive and happier.

I believe that it is our Christian duty to take excellent care of our bodies and that we should glorify God with our bodies. The Bible makes this very clear. It informs in Corinthians 6: 19, 20, "Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought price. Therefore, honour God with your body." From eating healthy to being physically active, from preventing and managing chronic diseases to preserving our mental health, from gardening to financial health, and from spiritual devotions to food demonstrations are all tenets of this transformative program.

From year to year, our programs are thematic. This year, our theme is, 'I Choose...,' with the intention of equipping and empowering our participants to make healthy lifestyle choices. It is also our hope that they will integrate these lifestyle principles and share them with their families, friends, and co-workers to spread the message of health and wellness.

Realizing the challenge that comes with making lifestyle changes, we've added a new feature to our program. Until the launch of our 2024 Program, we will engage our participants in monthly interactive educational sessions that will seek to encourage and motivate them as they journey toward achieving and maintaining excellent health.

We are indeed grateful to all our former Health Ministries Directors, local Health Ministries Leaders, the Adventist Health Professions Association, coaches, participants, sponsors, and all who played a role in making this annual Program an impactful one. We have heard the testimonies and the praise reports of participants. We have experienced the goodness and mercies of God each year it is conducted. May this Program continue to be a household name and a beacon in our community.

I appeal to you, and I challenge you to do all you can to protect and preserve your health. Let's by God's grace truly represent Him by living as healthy lives as we can and teaching others to do likewise. We look forward to continuing serving you as we seek to share and promote health.
