At that time, Elder Norman Seymour cognizant of the Royal Bahamas Police Force Church Service saw it fitting to host a church service specifically for Law Enforcement Officers in the Adventist Church.

Later, the service expanded to include Public Service Officers within the Adventist Church. The last service was held in 2018 at Hillview Seventh-day Adventist Church.
