OneVoice27 is part of a global initiative commemorating the 2,000th anniversary of Jesus Christ's earthly ministry, calling believers everywhere to rediscover the life and teachings of Jesus and proclaim His gospel through every available digital platform, culminating in a united global harvest on 25 September 2027. 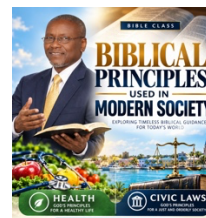

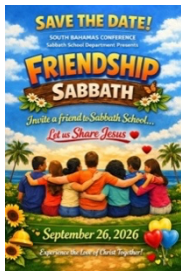

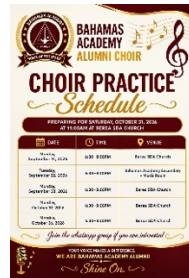


BA ALUMNI CHOIR
