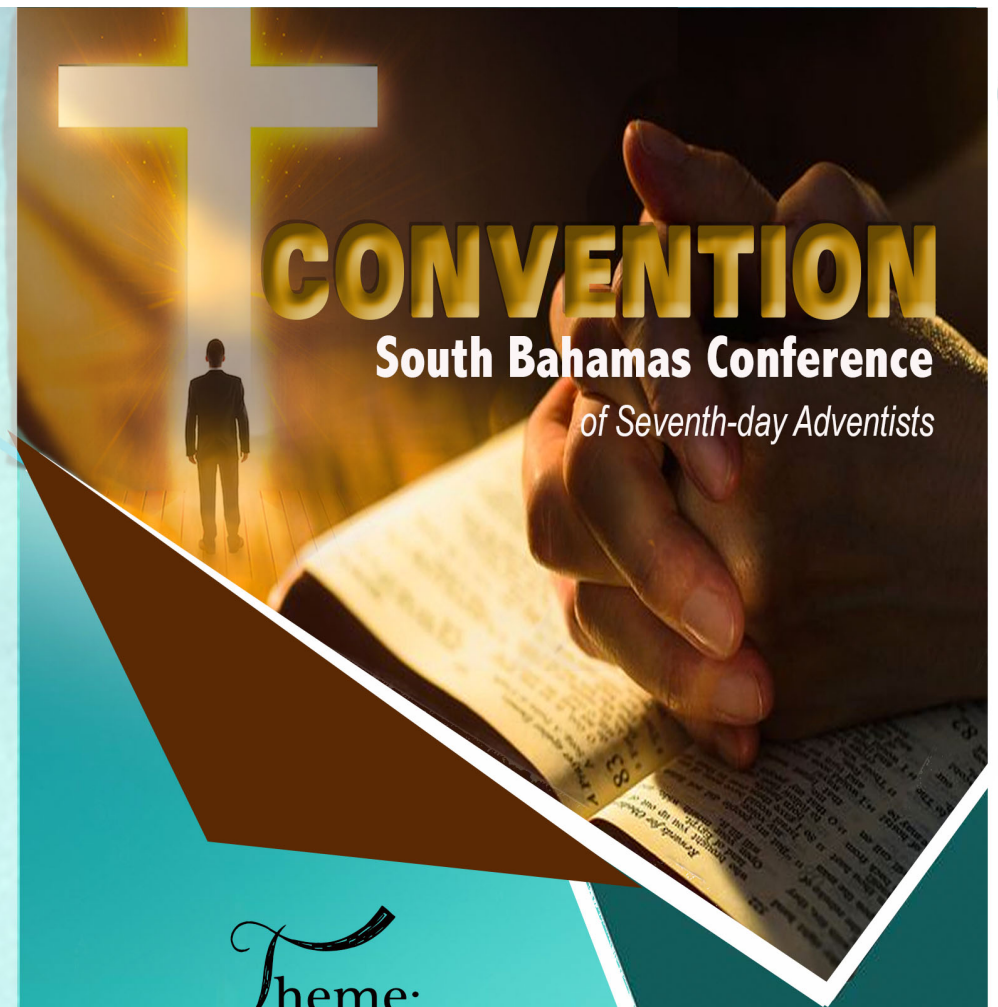
Kenneth Manders accepted Jesus as his personal Savior and was baptized in 1979. He began serving in the Bermuda Mission (now Conference) as a Literature Evangelist from 1980 -1984. At his last Literature Evangelism Retreat in Tampa, Florida, he met Claudette, his wife. The Lord has blessed their union with three sons; Andre, Stephen, and Joseph.

Pastor Manders began his ministry in 1995 as the Assistant Pastor of the South Hampton Seventh-day Adventist Church and co-currently served as the Bermuda Conference Assistant Youth Director. In 1997, he became the Bermuda Conference Youth Director and was also assigned as Pastor of the Somerst Seventh-day Adventist Church.

In 2002, he was assigned as the Senior Pastor to the Hamilton Seventh-day Advenist Church, a post he held for 13 years. He was then called to serve as the Executive Secretary of the Bermuda Conference where he served for two terms. On September 28, 2014, he was elected to serve as the President of the Bermuda Conference.
